

## **The 1st Multifunctional Materials for Defense Workshop (Theme: Power and Energy)**

You are invited to attend the *1st Multifunctional Materials for Defense Workshop* which will be held on May 13-14, 2010, at Hyatt Regency Reston, 1800 Presidents Street, Reston, Virginia 20190. The theme for our Workshop is "Power and Energy" covering a broad range of research programs sponsored by various DoD agencies. There will be an open discussion on the DoD strategy for the theme from 3:30 PM to 5:00 PM on the second day. We are looking forward to a stimulating meeting and opportunities for interactions between all participants in the program.

Our Workshop will be partially overlapped with the Annual Grantees'/Contractors' Meeting for *AFOSR Program Review on Mechanics of Multifunctional Materials & Microsystems (M<sup>4</sup>)* to be held on May 10-12, 2010, at the same location. All M<sup>4</sup> research grants and contracts dealing with the subject of "structural integration of energy harvesting and storage capabilities" will be reviewed on May 13 as a part of the Workshop. Also, it should be noted that the afternoon session of M<sup>4</sup> Program Review on May 12 will be devoted to the research grants started under a new AFOSR Initiative on "Energy Harvesting from Aerospace Environments." You are more than welcome to attend all sessions throughout the week.

### **ORAL PRESENTATIONS**

Unless specified otherwise (as in the case of multiple speakers or review talk), oral presentations are scheduled to be 20 minutes in length plus 5 minutes reserved for questions. We will strictly adhere to this 25-minute allotment per talk in order to keep to our busy schedule. It is expected that all presentations will be from computers and use an LCD projector which will be available. If you have any other specific audio-visual needs for your presentation, please contact us immediately.

### **REGISTRATION**
